2. Must be 55 years and over for participation.
3. Dessert dishes must be at a minimum of 50 sample portions, covered.
4. Please do not put your name on a visible spot on the container.
5. Sample spoons, bowls, and napkins will be provided by FCC.
6. Please make sure your BAKing dish is covered, hot/cold and ready for tasting.
7. The winner will be announced and prize handed out at 6:15pm. On Dec 9th.

Official Rules and Regulations for the Baking Cook-Off

The following rules are to be adhered to by all baking cooks, judges and/or assistants:

1. Baking Cook-Off is defined as any kind of baked good prepared homemade. The entry may choose from many different kinds of recipes for this Baking contest; including but not limited to; Bread regular grain, fruit bread, biscotti cookie, cookies, muffins, etc.
2. There is no entry fee. Entrants must be 55 years and over to enter.
3. All ingredients must be cooked and fully prepared prior to the event – Baked dishes are to be brought “ready-to-eat”.
4. Contestants are responsible for supplying all of their own serving utensils and products relating to their baked submission and maintenance of its proper temperature for serving. Spoons and cups for use to the public will be provided by FCC.
5. Each contestant must prepare a **Minimum** of 50 sample portions for competition.
6. Each contestant will be assigned a ‘contestants number’ by the Chief Scorekeeper and be given a judges container for their entry will be judged. Each contestant should verify that the number on the side of the container is the same as their contestants’ number assigned to them by the Chief Scorekeeper.
7. The decision of the judges is final. Judging will be based on score cards which are numbered. 100% of the score for prizes will be ‘People’s Choice”.
8. Each contestant is responsible for policing and cleaning up the area at the end of the day and removing all items from the area. No items shall be allowed to remain after the close of the Cook – off.

There will be a Peoples’ choice ballot box for people to vote for their favorite top 3 dessert dishes by contestant number. The Dessert dish with the most nominees for the best overall dish wins the 1st Prize. 2nd and 3rd prize winners are awarded accordingly as the first.

Fruita Community Center will provide the cups and spoons for sampling the dessert dishes.
