Tuesday's City Council Meeting

Tuesday's agenda includes a proclamation for Prematurity Awareness Day, swearing in of Officer Gianinetti, a 2016 General Fund overview, an item to repeal and reenact ordinance sections relating to solicitation and peddling, an item to repeal a section regarding loitering, an item concerning the nomination petition deadlines for the municipal election, and a Brandon Estates Subdivision Improvements Agreement (SIA).

Little Salt Wash Trail

The low bid contractor is in the process of appealing CDOT's non-concurrence of the bid related to not meeting the state's established Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) goal. There is a high chance we will need to conduct another bid process. We have updated GOCO regarding the status and need for an extension and staff will support an extension request to the GOCO Board in December, so it looks promising an extension may be granted. We are continuing to work closely with CDOT and GOCO to see this trail completed.

We continue to have press cover our unique community engagement project and continue to receive packets.
