## **Tuesday Night's City Council Meeting**

We are keeping Tuesday night's agenda light so as to wish Counselor Fuller farewell and adjourn early into a workshop to kick-off our Priority Based Budgeting process with the Center for Priority Based Budgeting.

## TID BITS:

• The state asked us for maps ready for the web and a statement of support for their upcoming announcement (hopefully next week) of the governor's announcement of 16 in 16 trails. This means our trail submission is in the list of trails for final consideration!

• I had the opportunity to meet with the BLM's Associate State Director, Greg Shoop Tuesday to share with him Fruita's efforts and partnership with the local BLM office.

• We had a conference call with the University Technical Assistance program regarding the feedback from the gateway design packets Tuesday. Out of 91 submitted packets 88 included feedback and three letters were received. We will share the summarized feedback report soon.

• The Forfeiture Board met this week and it looks like the funds approved this year for our security cameras will still be available.

• The FCC has been very busy. We have lots of volleyball players signed up and gym space is very limited and we are partnering with the Middle School to accommodate.

• Staff is setting up a benefit golf tournament in conjunction with the Mike the Headless Chicken Festival as well as a disc golf tournament.

- We are also seeking additional business sponsors for the Mike Fest.
- Christmas décor is coming down.

• The student who is doing a class project and created a petition regarding the skate park met with the Parks & Recreation board voicing interest in more skilled features at the park and will be at the Jan. workshop.

• A recommendation to the City Council for approval of a vacation rental by owner at 325 S. Apple was passed by the Planning Commission on Tuesday night.

• Staff will be attending the 5-2-1 Board meeting next week.
