TID BITS:

- The Mayor and I had a great meeting with a prospective business that we connected with last year and is still planning to relocate here in the first quarter of 2018.
- Continued productive discussions with another prospective company as well.
- Had a great meeting with Ken Mabery, Colorado National Monument, discussing how the City and CNM can partner in more ways and stay connected.
- Had a great meeting with Curtis Englehart, the new Director for the Workforce Center, to discuss ongoing partnerships and how to better communicate stats on our skilled workforce to prospective companies.
- In a year over year comparison from the state demographer, Fruita has had the highest percentage increase (37%) in housing starts in the Grand Valley.
- The Planning Commission will continue with training at their Jan. meeting.
- We plan to bring final concepts plans for the Gateway and the Lagoons for adoption at the Jan. 17 meeting.
- Engineering is meeting with effected property regarding easements for the Alley and drainage project between Mulberry and Peach.
- They are also beginning to meet with property owners regarding the downtown phase II design.
