On April 2, 2024, the City of Fruita held the bi-annual municipal election. Residents were asked to elect a Mayor and fill three City Council seats. Out of the 9,696 ballots that were issued to registered voters, 2,789 participated in the election by casting their ballots. Matthew Breman was elected Mayor of the City for a two year term and Richard Parrish, Aaron Hancey, and Andrea Stolarczyk were elected to four-year terms on the City Council. The show can be seen from almost anywhere in Fruita! A few popular public viewing areas are Rotary Park and the Visitor Center.

Fireworks are launched at the James M. Robb State Park. Parking will be limited at the James M. Robb State Park. Snooks Bottom Open Space will be closed to the public for the entire day and during the show. For more information on the event including traffic control and viewing best practices visit fruita.org.

The City of Fruita would like to remind residents to refrain from using personal



fireworks as they are a fire hazard and can be disruptive. The Colorado State fireworks statute states it is unlawful for any person to discharge fireworks other than permissible fireworks (typically fireworks that do not leave the ground), anywhere in the state. The City of Fruita Municipal Code also has a noise ordinance stating that it is unlawful for any person to make, continue or cause to be made or continued any unnecessary, unusually loud or unusual noise between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) p.m. and six o'clock (6:00) a.m., which either annoys, injures or endangers the comfort, repose, health or safety of other persons.

19 ROAD IMPROVEMENTS (COMING FALL 2024)

The City of Fruita is planning utility and roadway improvements along 19 Road from Highway 6 & 50 north to J.2 Road. The improvements are expected to begin after the irrigation season in early November and last until summer 2025. Improvements are expected to consist of the following:

- Sanitary sewer installation from the canal north to J.2 Rd.
- Storm drain installation from the canal north to J.2 Rd.
- Irrigation line and structure improvements at J Rd. and J.2 Rd., including the replacement of the line along the west edge of 19 Rd. from J Rd. south to Iron Drive
- Road widening
- · Pedestrian path installation

Work associated with the project will begin in early fall. You can expect slowdowns and traffic control. Please check back for more updates on specific street closures.



REED PARK REDESIGN OPENING SUMMER 2024

This July, Reed Park will reopen to the community with new amenities to enjoy!
Reed Park was built in 1984 and is the heaviest-used park in Fruita aside from Little Salt Wash.

Renovations included replacement of the existing restroom and shelter structure, replacement of the playground, electrical upgrades for special events, the installation





of a MiniPitch that includes basketball, soccer, and pickleball lines, and the addition of a new skate/wheel park. The park also includes a new merry-go-round and horseshoe pits. You will also find local artwork made from the old beloved Reed Park merry-go-round. These renovations wouldn't have been possible without funding from the US Soccer Foundation Grant, PlayCore CPRA Grant, and Great Outdoors Colorado.

OF WEEDS

Please help maintain our beautiful smalltown atmosphere by removing weeds and trimming trees and brush. Residents and owners are responsible for keeping their property free of weeds and trees.

Here are a few helpful guidelines to ensure your property (residential and/or business) is following the City of Fruita's code:



Cut all weeds that are 12 inches in height or higher to the ground and remove them for your property.



Remove all weeds on your property starting at the curb of the sidewalk/street.



If your property is in junction with an alley way, please clear weeds starting at the center point of the alley.

Keep in mind:

- If you spray any weeds with herbicide, all dead vegetation must be removed.
- Keep irrigation ditches and easements free of weeds and debris.
- All weeds and brush must be properly disposed of by bagging, bundling, placing in trashcans or hauling to the Mesa County Compost Facility.
