

## **2020 Trick or Treat Street Guidelines for Participating Businesses**

*The Fruita Area Chamber of Commerce is working closely with Mesa County Public Health to ensure that all guidelines for Outdoor Events with high participation movement are followed.*

*The FACC will be requiring that trick or treaters register using parent or guardian contact information per health department regulations. Two check in stations will be set up at the FACC office (432 E. Aspen Ave. Fruita) and at the Circle Park Gazebo where participants will receive a map of participating businesses. Sidewalks will be marked with 6 ft. social distancing guidelines with one-way traffic.*

### **The Fruita Area Chamber of Commerce recommends the following guidelines for participating businesses:**

- Please wear a mask when interacting with trick or treaters
- Do not allow trick or treaters to reach hands directly into the candy bucket
- Please pre-bag candy if possible
- Participating businesses are encouraged to have hand sanitizer available and use sanitizer regularly
- Encourage frequent handwashing among employees interacting with Trick or Treat Street attendees
- If you or your staff are experiencing symptoms of illness, stay home and please do not participate in Trick or Treat Street
