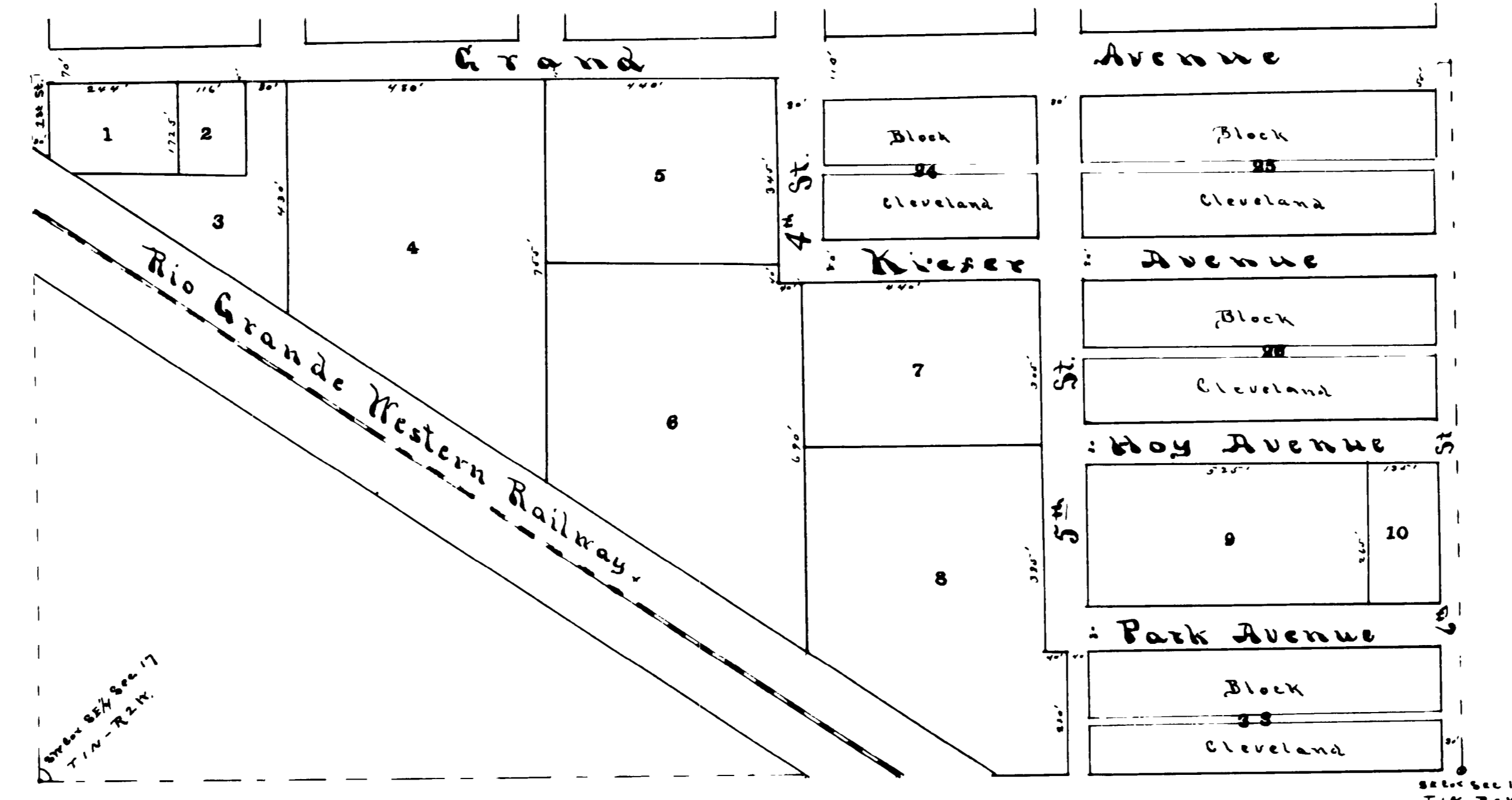
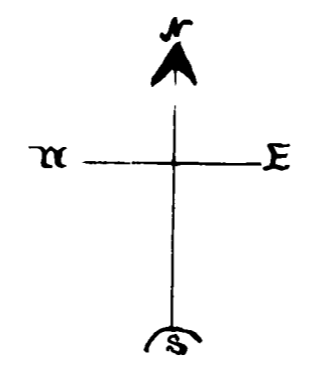


MAP
