


Plat of South 440 feet. of

Dedication and Acknowledgement.

Know all men by these presents:

That I, C.J. Tongent, of the County of Mesa and State of Colorado, do hereby declare: That I own in fee simple the south 440 feet of the west half of Tract 65, of "Orchard Sub-Division" of the north-east quarter of Section 17, Township 1 North, Range 2 West of the Old Principal Meridian, within the Town of Fruita, Mesa County, Colorado, and said parcel of land is clear of all liens and all taxes are paid.

That I caused said parcel of land to be platted by Fred Lovenhagen, a surveyor with office at Fruita, Colorado; and the plat thereof on this page does accurately represent the described parcel of land. That all Lots and Block are numbered and the dimensions of all Lots, Block, Streets, Avenues and Alleys are shown thereon, their boundaries given, scale of said plat is indicated, with reference to monument as set out and shown on said plat.

That a strip 30 feet wide on the west thereof to be known as "Orchard Street". A strip 30 feet on the east thereof to be known as "Gash Street" and an Alley north and south through center thereof, 15 feet wide, are hereby set off and forever dedicated to the public for use as highways and public uses.

That the north 140 feet of the west half of said Tract 65, was heretofore platted and said plat filed on the 2nd day of Oct. 1909, A.D. 1909, and recorded in Book 3, page 30, and the parcel of land shown on said plat and this plat constitute and comprise the west half of said Tract 65. Block 1, now all said west half of Tract 65, sub-divided into 27 lots. Lots 1 to 5 inclusive are shown on said former plat, and lots 6 to 27 inclusive are shown on this plat. That Lots 6 to 27 inclusive are each 127 1/2 feet east and west, and 40 feet north and south. That said described parcel of land, so above described, and so platted on this page, shall be designated, known and is hereby named

"C.J. Tongent's Second Addition"

to the Town of Fruita, Colorado.






