Acknowledgement and dedication.

I, C.J. Dugent, do hereby declare; That I am owner  
of the North one hundred and forty feet of the West one-half of  
Tract numbered Sixty five of "Orchard Subdivision" of the North  
East quarter of Section seventeen, in Township One North,  
in Range two West of the Ute Principal Meridian in  
Mesa County, Colorado.

That I caused said parcel of land to be platted by F. Lowen-  
hagen, a surveyor, and the plat thereof, on this page does accu-  
rately represent said parcel of land and all Blocks, Lots, Streets  
and Alleys thereof.

That I do hereby dedicate, give and grant for use as  
highways; 30 feet off of the East thereof as part of a street,  
to be known as "Ash Street"; 30 feet off of the West there-  
of as part of a street, to be known as "Orchard Street" and 15  
feet off of the South thereof for an Alley.

That Block One thereof is 270 feet East and West  
and 125 feet North and South, that the five lots numbered  
from one to five inclusive are each 125 feet North and South  
and lots 1 and 5 are each 60 feet East and West and lots  
2, 3 and 4 are each 50 feet East and West.

That the parcel of land represented on this plat shall  
be designated, named and known as "C.J. Dugent's First  
Addition to the Town of Fruita.


