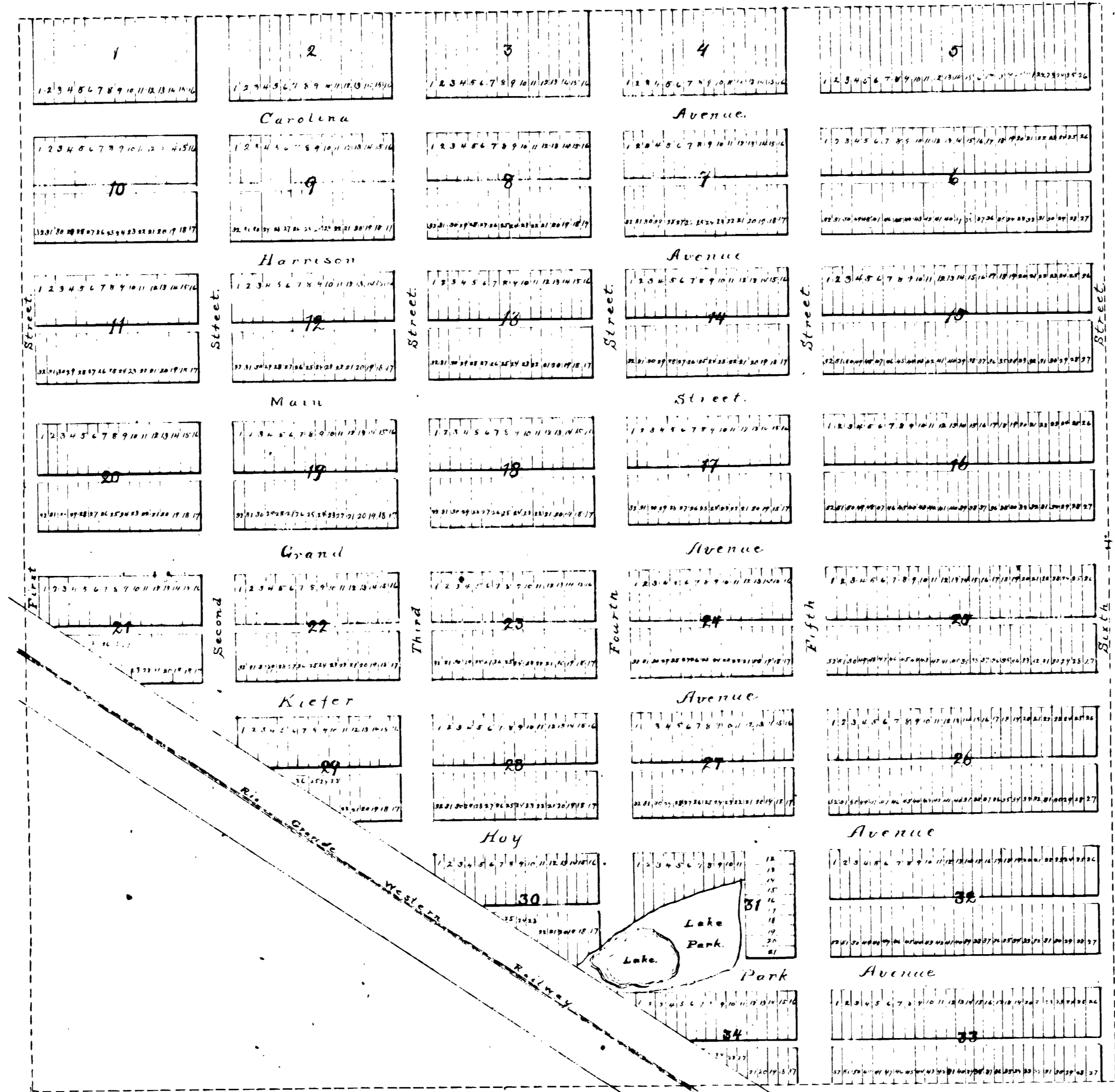


MAP

Mer. in the County of Mesa and State of Colorado lying north of the Rio Grande National Railway Company main railroad track as now constructed thro said quarter section; that said tract is laid out as appraised as the site of a town to be called The Town of Cleveland; that the said The Cleveland Town and Mercantile Company is the owner and proprietor of the tract so laid out and platted, and does by these presents forever dedicate to the public use the right of way over and thro all the streets and alleys shown in said plat.

In witness whereof the said The Cleveland Town and Mercantile Company has caused these presents to be signed by its President and attested by its Secretary and its corporate seal to be hereunto affixed this nineteenth day of November A.D. 1890.

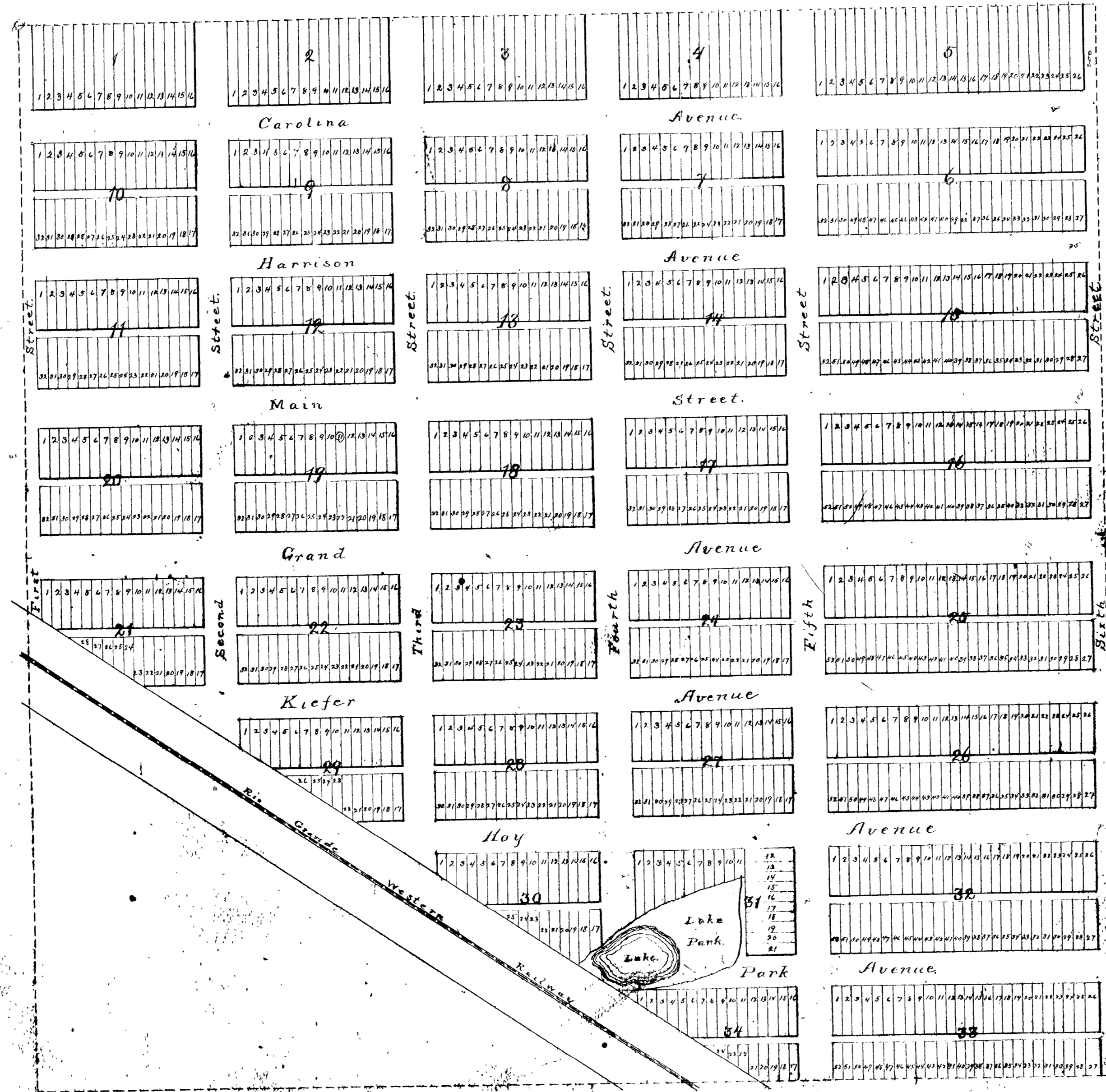
