


O. O. Fellows'

Owner's Dedication and Acknowledgment.  
I, O. O. Fellows do hereby declare, that I am the owner of the West one hundred seventy-two and  $\frac{1}{2}$  feet of tract twenty-nine of Orchard Subdivision of the North East quarter of Section seventeen in Township One North, Range two West of the 10th Principal Meridian in Mesa County, Colorado, and all taxes are paid.

That I caused said parcel of land to be platted by Fred Lowenkagen, a surveyor and it is the plat thereof on this page does accurately represent the described land, and all Lots, Blocks, Streets and alleys thereof.

I do hereby dedicate to the public for use as highway 30 feet off of south thereof to be known as Columbine Street, 30 feet off of the West thereof to be known as Maple Street and 15 feet off of the East thereof as an alley.

That said described land is divided into block 1, containing lots 1 to 6, both inclusive, that lots 1 and 2 are each 41 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet north and south and 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet east and west, that lots 3, 4, 5 and 6 are each 50 feet north and south and 12 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet east and west.

That the described land as represented on the plat on this page shall be named, known and designated as "O. O. Fellows' First Addition to the Town of Fruita".




