### Owners Acknowledgement and Dedication.

I, Wallace A. Merricell, do hereby declare that I am owner of the East half, of North East quarter, of North West quarter of Section Seventeen in Township one North, in Range Two West of the Ute Principal Meridian, being otherwise described as Tracts 26, 27, 36 and 37 of Orchard Subdivision of the North half of the Northwest quarter, of said Section seventeen, all of which is within the corporate limits of the Town of Fruita Colorado.

That I caused said parcels of land to be surveyed and platted by Fred Lowenhagen, a surveyor and the plat thereof on this page does accurately represent all blocks, lots, streets and alleys thereof and I do hereby dedicate to the public for use as highways, one street 60 feet wide, through and near the center of said plat, north and south, to be known as Elm Street. One street 60 feet wide through center of said plat east and west, to be known as "Columbine Street," an alley 14 feet wide running north and south through center of each of the four blocks as shown on said plat.

That Maple Street bounds said plat on the east, Otley Street on the north, Peach Street on the west and Labor Avenue on the south.

That Block one is 594<sup>45</sup> feet north and south on the east and 594<sup>55</sup> feet north and south on the west side and 290 feet east and west, divided into 24 lots; Lot 1 is 138 feet east and west by 44<sup>45</sup> feet north and south on the east and 44<sup>55</sup> feet north and south on the west end; Lot 24 is 138 feet east and west by 44<sup>55</sup> feet north and south on the east and 44<sup>45</sup> feet north and south on the west end. The remaining 22 lots are each 50 feet north and south and 138 feet east and west.

That Block two is 594<sup>51</sup> feet north and south on the east side and 594<sup>22</sup> feet north and south on the west side and 260 feet east and west, divided into 24 lots, of which Lot 1 is 123 feet east and west by 44<sup>51</sup> feet north and south on the east and 44<sup>22</sup> feet north and south on the west end; Lot 24 is 123 feet east and west, and 44<sup>22</sup> feet north and south on the east and 44<sup>51</sup> feet north and south on the west end, the remaining 22 lots are each 50 feet north and south and 123 feet east and west.


