Alley Motioned to accept the minutes from June's DAB meeting and Were seconded by Madeline

City Update-Dan talked about the city's upcoming plan for street closures of Mulberry and Peach. Each closure will have outdoor Seating and common spaces– plans were handed out to all on the board. The lighting poles will be started in the next week and a half. Looking to finish Early to mid-September timeframe. The city will have 2 a day cleaning – this along with the porta johns will be handled by a third-party company. The hopes are to make this semi-permanent.

The Plan Will be opening up to social media feedback very soon. Dan Also talked about delivering tents and usable spaces to schools to help with creating usable outdoor teaching/learning spaces.

Library update – They have resumed full hours at the branch. For August and September, they are offering in person programing. This week they hosted Discovery Kids. working with Very small groups for this programing at Community Center. After September going back to virtual programing again. Community Read project – Working with Karen Leonhart and Mike Bennett – Discussions on equality. Formed a committee to do an open house at the civic center park 9/12 – to gather feedback on where the community at on this subject.
