The Defendant shall complete any counseling, educational, medical or psychiatric treatment if so ordered by the Court and promptly file verification of attendance and/or completion as ordered by the court. 4. The Defendant shall submit to substance testing at the direction of the court, and it will be at your expense. 5. The Defendant shall make restitution or reparation to the victim of his or her conduct for the damage or injury which was sustained, and the Defendant shall pay all Court costs and fines as determined by the court. 6. The Defendant shall obtain counseling or treatment for drug abuse, alcohol abuse, or mental condition and shall remain in a specified residential treatment facility if necessary for that purpose, as required by the court. The Defendant may be responsible for the cost of the treatment program. 7. The Defendant shall successfully complete all useful public service as ordered by the Court, within the time period determined by the court. The Defendant shall file with the Court Clerk completion of the community service.

8. The Defendant shall comply with any other requirements imposed by the court.
