

ORDINANCE 2014-04

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE FRUITA CITY COUNCIL AMENDING CHAPTER 33,
ANIMAL REGULATIONS, OF TITLE 17, FRUITA LAND USE CODE, OF THE
FRUITA MUNICIPAL CODE IN RELATION TO BEE KEEPING
(Application #2013-18)**

WHEREAS, members of the Fruita community have identified the benefits of bee keeping and requested an amendment to the City's regulations regarding bee keeping, and

WHEREAS, the Fruita City Council directed staff to prepare an Ordinance to amend the Land Use Code to allow bee keeping similar to regulations in other areas of Mesa County, and

WHEREAS, the Fruita Planning Commission held a public hearing on December 10, 2013, and recommended approval of the proposed Land Use Code amendment to allow bee keeping, and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held before the City Council on January 7, and again on February 4, 2014, regarding the proposed bee keeping amendment to the Land Use Code.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRUITA, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The table in Section 17.33.03, of Chapter 33 of Title 17 of the Fruita Municipal Code is hereby amended to remove the language as follows:
