# A RESOLUTION OF THE FRUITA CITY COUNCIL SETTING A HEARING DATE TO DETERMINE THE ELIGIBILITY OF CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY TO BE ANNEXED TO THE CITY OF FRUITA AND TO CONSIDER INITIATION OF ANNEXATION PROCEDURES LATIGO SUBDIVISION ANNEXATION

**WHEREAS,** the City of Fruita has received a petition for annexation of property into the City limits of Fruita which is signed by 100% of the property owners of the property requested to be annexed, and

WHEREAS, the City of Fruita finds it necessary to annex certain real property which is contiguous to the city limits to promote the health, safety and welfare of the community; and

**WHEREAS,** annexation of such property would accommodate efficient provision of public services and would equitably distribute the cost of providing public services amongst those who benefit from public services provided by the community.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE FRUITA CITY COUNCIL** to hold a public hearing on May 1, 2007 at 7:00 p.m., at the Fruita City Hall, 325 E. Aspen, Fruita, Colorado, to determine if the real property described and shown on Exhibit A complies with Colorado Revised Statues 31-12-104, 105 and 106 and is eligible for annexation and to consider the adoption of a proposed resolution to initiate procedures to annex said real property to the City of Fruita.
