

ORDINANCE 2015-10

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9.02.002 (F) OF THE FRUITA MUNICIPAL CODE CONCERNING USE OF SOUND AMPLIFICATION DEVICES TO EXCLUDE SPECIAL EVENTS OPERATED UNDER PERMIT ISSUED BY THE CITY

WHEREAS, a license is required to operate sound amplification devices in the City of Fruita and payment of a license fee for each day, as established by the Annual Fees and Charges Resolution, is required, and

WHEREAS, the requirement for obtaining a sound amplification license excludes certain uses including parades and processions which are operated under a permit in accordance with the Fruita Municipal Code, and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this ordinance to also exclude events held pursuant to a Special Event Permit issued by the City from the sound amplification licensing requirements

BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FRUITA, COLORADO:

Section 1: That Section 9.02.002.F of Chapter 9.02 of the Fruita Municipal Code, entitled Use of Sound Amplification Devices, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9.02.002 USE OF SOUND AMPLIFICATION DEVICES.

F. EXCLUSIONS. This section shall not apply to radios in homes or in private vehicles, when the same are operated in such manner as not to be audible at a distance of fifty feet from such vehicle, nor to noise devices, bands, or other musical devices used in any public parade, ~~or~~ procession, **OR SPECIAL EVENT** which is operated under a permit **ISSUED BY THE CITY** ~~in accordance with the ordinance of the City.~~
