Over 150 million years ago, dinosaurs roamed the Grand Valley. Remains of these ancient ecosystems are found today in the layers of the Morrison Formation. This hike includes ten points of interest sure to delight all ages!

Family Hikes cost \$5 and participants must register ahead of time. Each Family Hike will conclude with an interpretive talk from Julia with Dinosaur Journey. Bring a snack, water, and good shoes. Due to the statewide mandate, masks are required while together for group talks. Hikers are asked to remain at least 6 feet apart on the trail.
