Fruitadens is a tiny, tusked dinosaur named for Fruita, where it was first found.

Stego Route



The Stegosaurus is Colorado's official state fossil and is found locally.

Apato Route



Apatosaurus was found in 1901 by Elmer Riggs at Dinosaur Hill.

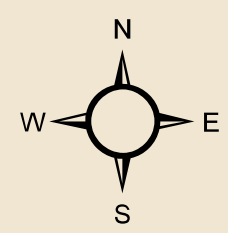
Note: undeveloped or primitive trails on BLM property south and west of the Colorado River are designated non-mechanized travel only.
